

Pea Ridge City Council
Special Meeting
October 27, 2022

The Pea Ridge City Council met in a Special Meeting on Thursday, October 27, 2022 at 4:30 p.m., in the Council Room at the City Hall Administration Building.

Those present were: City Clerk Sandy Button, Council Members Ginger Larsen, Merrill White, Steve Guthrie, and Cody Keene. Ben Griffin, TischlerBise was present via Zoom. Also, present was City Attorney Shane Perry.

City Clerk Button called the meeting to order.

City Clerk Button opened the meeting in prayer and led those present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

City Clerk Button read Resolution Number 488, which is entitled:

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE POLICY MANUAL OF
THE PEA RIDGE POLICE DEPARTMENT AS
PUMULGATED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE;
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

Alderman White moved, seconded by Alderman Keene to approve Resolution Number 488. The roll being called, the vote was as follows: Ginger Larsen voted aye; Merrill White voted aye; Steve Guthrie voted aye; and Cody Keene voted aye. Motion passed.

The Council discussed Ordinance No. 776, concerning adopting a capital plan and establishing level of service standards for new water and sewer impact fees. Several questions were asked concerning this ordinance. Particularly the option of having impact fees repay debt for prior projects. Other questions about the ratio between water purchased and water treated and current and future capacity at the plant.

Alderman White, seconded by Alderman Guthrie moved to table Ordinance No. 776 at this time.
